

Terms and conditions: Camden Physical Activity Needs Assessment Prize Draw

1. The 'Camden Physical Activity Needs Assessment Prize Draw' competition (Competition) starts on Monday 12th February 2018. It closes at 23:59 on Friday 16th March 2018. Entries received after this will not be considered.
2. To enter the Prize Draw you must complete the Camden Physical Activity Needs Assessment Residents Survey and submit your name, telephone number and email address. Failure to do so will invalidate your entry into this competition. No purchase is necessary and entry is free. 3. By entering the competition you are accepting these terms and conditions
4. The survey can be completed online at www.camden.gov.uk/PANA or by filling out a paper version of the survey which is available at Libraries, Leisure Centres and through Camden Sport and Physical Activity Service
5. This competition is limited to one entry per person.
6. Entrants must be over the age of 16 to enter this competition
7. One winner will be chosen from a random draw of entries received in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. The draw will be performed by a random computer process. The draw will take place on 26th March 2018.
8. The winner will receive an iPad, 32GB, wifi, silver.
9. Camden Council accepts no responsibility for any costs associated with the prize and not specifically included in the prize. You are responsible for the cost (if any) of sending you entry to us.
10. The winner will be notified by email on or before 30th March 2018 and must provide a postal address to claim their prize. If a winner does not respond to Camden Council within 14 days of being notified by Camden Council, then the winner's prize will be forfeited and Camden Council shall be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above (and that winner will have to respond to notification of their win within 14 days or else they will also forfeit their prize).
