Camden School Admissions are not centralised, so therefore it is the parent's responsibility to secure a school place for their child/ren at a school. The schools hold the vacancy list, so therefore you would have to make in year applications to the schools directly or using the online system. We may not be aware which schools have vacancies, as the schools are fully responsible for this, and vacancy details can change quickly.
