

### Camden Climate Map

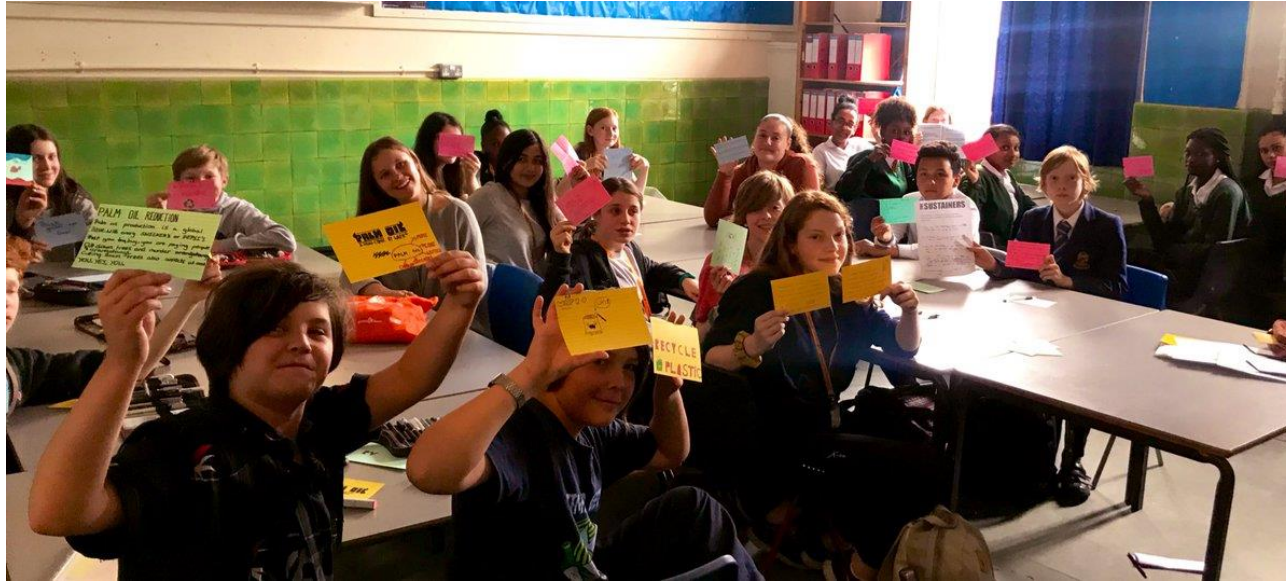
