DANE STREET, EAGLE STREET, RED LION SQUARE – removal of the paid-for parking place situated on the east side adjacent to the vehicular entrance to Halsey House. Designation of a 24-hour waiting prohibition by vehicles along the length of Dane Street except where parking places remain designated, and at its junctions with Eagle Street and Red Lion Square.





STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1 The proposals seek to create safer and healthier streets for people in Camden, following the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and are in alignment with, the Camden Plan. which responds to Camden 2025; the objectives of the Camden Transport Strategy; and, the Climate Action Plan.
- 1.2 The proposals meet the objectives set out in these documents by transforming streets and creating clean, vibrant, and sustainable places; by reducing motor traffic levels; and, by making it easier for people to travel on foot or by cycle. The proposals prioritise space for the most efficient modes and seek to create high quality environments and spaces of public realm that are accessible and inclusive, enable modal shift and increase active, healthy travel.
- 1.3 The proposals, if implemented, would provide space on Dane Street to facilitate better management, of motor vehicles, and facilitate enhanced pedestrian and cycle infrastructure.
- 1.4 In response to feedback received the order will revoke 12m of residents bays outside (outside no 26 and no 41 Hartland Road) and replace them with a 24 hour prohibition on waiting (including for the purposes of loading / unloading) to ensure sufficient space is available to facilitate U turn movements, of motor vehicles, taking place north of the motor vehicle restriction on Hartland Road
