A new 'living wall' along Robert Street

New 'green walls'

We have installed four new 'living walls' in your neighbourhood. The newly planted green walls are located at the side of the Grasmere, Patterdale, Borrowdale and Derwent buildings along Robert Street. Over time, the plants will flourish to span the height of the wire mesh installed on each wall. We've used Evergreen Clematis Armandi, Star Jasmin, low growing ferns and Hellebores which have properties to help improve and clean the air, absorb sound and increase biodiversity.

Euston Planning Brief consultation postponed

The Council has postponed consultation on the Euston Planning Brief due to the pre-election period, commencing on Wednesday 6 November. This is ahead of the general election which will be held on Thursday 12 December.

We need to give further thought to future timings on the consultation, hope to have a clearer picture in the next couple of weeks.

The letter urges HS2 to prioritise the health and safety of residents, find better ways to support communities living in HS2 affected areas, and to offer respite to people living nearby demolition sites.

Circa 1880s fountain restored

One of Camden's oldest fountains. formerly located at St James Gardens, is almost fully restored. The circa 1880s cast iron fountain was damaged in a fire and we've been working with Metalcraft to restore it to its former glory. This work is funded by an assurance the Council received from HS2. With the loss of St James Gardens to make way for HS2, the treasured fountain will soon find a new home at the St Pancras Parish Church gardens. Once relocated, the fountain will make the final step in improvement works to the south garden of St **Pancras Church Gardens have been** completed.

Road closures near you

Existing closures: The section of Stanhope Street between Mackworth Street and Park Village East will be closed in phases for the demolition of the Eskdale building. The footpath will remain open for pedestrians and a diversion will be in place for vehicles.

Robert Street will be closed between Stanhope Street and Hampstead Road until January 2020. Works will take place in three phases to allow for vehicle access.

From mid-November works will take place in the east bound lane of Cardington Street close to the junction with Hampstead Road.
