

Kentish Town Planning Framework - Adoption Statement

In accordance with regulations 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, this Adoption Statement gives notice that the London Borough of Camden resolved to adopt the Kentish Town Planning Framework on 17th July 2020.

The Planning Framework is a supplementary planning document. It provides additional information and detailed guidance on the application of the Council's planning policies relating to this specific area of the borough. As a supplementary planning document the planning framework will be, where relevant, a material consideration in the Council's planning decision-making for the specific area.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the Kentish Town Planning Framework may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made not later than 6 weeks after the date on which the supplementary planning document was adopted.
