You'll see that some classes have a free crèche – subject to demand.

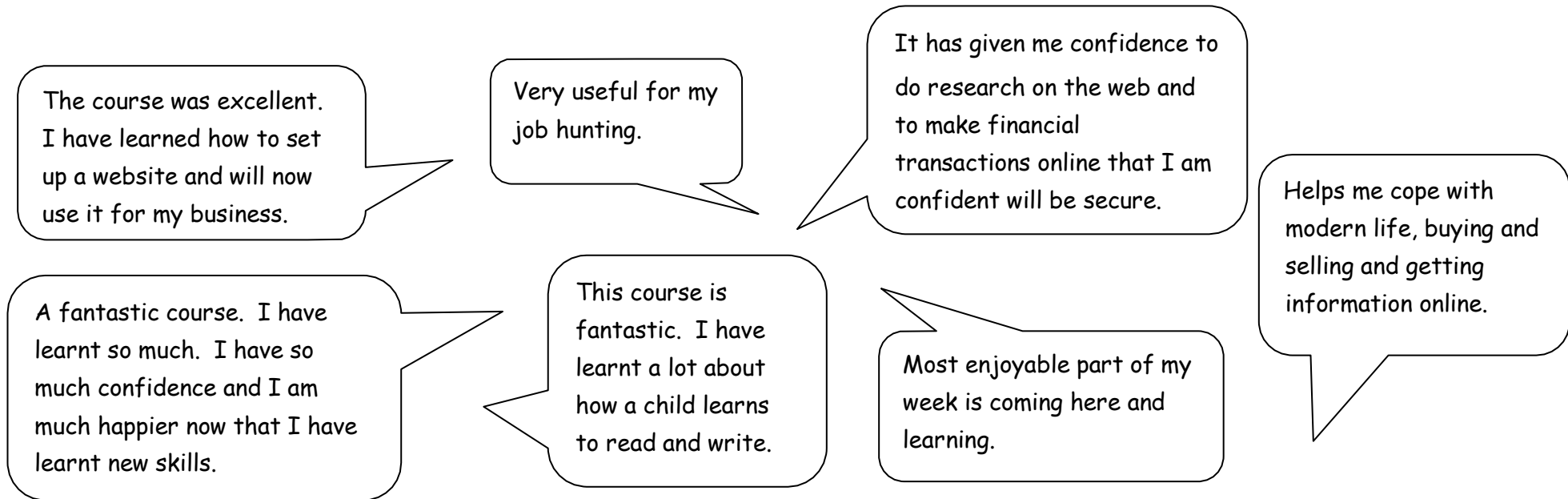
