

**From 1<sup>st</sup> November 2017 these charges will apply for the registration of births, deaths, marriages and giving notice of marriage or civil partnership:**

**All short certificates issued at the time of registration of a birth**      **£11**

Adding a new forename within 12 months of registering a birth:      **£40**

**Correction** of a birth, death or marriage registration:      **£75**

**Correction** of a birth, death or marriage registration that has to be sent to the General Register Office (GRO) for approval:      **£90**

Consideration of a divorce/civil partnership dissolution that took place outside the British Isles when giving notice      **£50**

If divorce/civil partnership dissolution has to be sent to the General Register Office (GRO) for approval      **£75**

***\* It is the responsibility of the informant providing the information to ensure the accuracy of a registration and is advised to check the entry carefully before signing. Registrars will not take responsibility for any errors that occur and once an entry is locked a correction application will have to be made for which the relevant charges will apply***
