Legal Officer Marsha Phillips has reviewed the email received on 18 October 2022 from Mark Oakley Judge & Priestley LLP, who is the Applicant in this matter.

Directions were issued in this case on 13 October 2022 and set out the timetable for the parties to prepare.

The Applicant has requested for an extension of time to comply with directions paragraph 1, to inform the Leaseholders of the application. The reason for the request is to allow them collocate information to submit to the printers, in order to use the facility of bulk mailing out services, to send out the information to the Leaseholders. They also, note that are planned postal strikes on 20 and 25 October which may create backlogs of post in early November

The Tribunal has considered the request and has decided that the requested should be granted. This extension will allow Applicant sufficient time to issue out the information to the Leaseholders. As this will have an impact on the Respondent, the other dates in the directions have also been varied. A copy of Amended Directions are attached to this letter.
