

PROPOSED CHANGES TO RESIDENT PERMIT CHARGES

To help deliver our Vision of enabling more sustainable travel in Camden, healthier lifestyles and less polluted places, our current and emerging (draft) Camden Transport Strategy (CTS) contains clear commitments and measures to reduce car ownership, car use and motor traffic levels in the Borough. The CTS and emerging (draft) Camden Clean Air Action Plan also have focused measures to reduce levels of transport-based emissions, including both pollutants that contribute to poor local air quality, and carbon dioxide that contributes to climate change.

In line with these commitments and our overarching transport and air quality goals, from April 2019, we are proposing to amend our current resident permit prices as set out below.
