Throughout the covid-19 outbreak your community liaison team have been working hard to raise your queries and concerns with the HS2 helpdesk, including noise, pollution and road closures.

Additionally the team have been identifying night workers and residents with medical/health issues, particularly those who may need more assistance during loud daytime construction works.

HS2 road works in your area

Water diversion works are currently underway in Harrington Street, taking place over three phases. Phase one includes a closure for two weeks between the junction of Varndell Street and the access road to

the Cartmel block. Phase two will of the Hampstead Road include a closure for two weeks between the access road to Cartmel and Mackworth Street. Phase three will include a closure between Varndell Street and Mackworth Street.

While HS2 carry out works to divert power cables in your neighbourhood, a partial closure northbound footpath is in place. Pedestrians are being diverted to the southbound footpath, and the Silverdale bus stop B is suspended and temporarily relocated south towards the Cartmel block. The closure is expected to be in place until 11 September.

Green space improvements this Autumn

We will soon be taking forward plans for green space improvements in your area. This includes a new sports pitch at Augustus House Gardens, and better green spaces near Harrington House, and the Langdale and Kirkstone blocks. You'll hear more from us soon so please stay tuned for updates.

We are working harder than ever to support your community while HS2 works are underway during the COVID-19 pandemic. HS2 have advised us that they will continue to review the works on their constructions sites in your area in line with Government and Public Health England advice on COVID-19.
