### HS2 lorry routes

We are committed to ensuring that HS2 reduces the number of lorries in your neighbourhood while works are underway. In June we secured a 10 mph speed limit on Varndell and Harrington Streets for all HS2 lorries weighing over 7.5 tonnes. Although lorries continue to disrupt your area, the speed limit reduces the chance of accidents. We've received a number of comments from residents about HS2's application for lorry routes on Stanhope and Robert streets, and we will consider these in full before a decision is made. ### Supporting you to feel safe and secure

The **Euston Wellbeing Team** are a community safety patrol team helping to respond to your concerns about crime and anti-social behaviour in the area. Since July 2019, they have carried out more than 1,280 interventions.

We've enclosed a flyer which demonstrates how they are responding to issues raised in the Regent's Park ward.

Our **Responsive Security Patrol (RSP)** team also operate on your estate and can help respond to your concerns about noise, rough sleeping, drug use and other disturbances. Since June the team have carried out

We're pleased to welcome three new community liaison assistants who will be based at the Camden Citizens' Advice Bureau on Albany Street from January 2020.

As local residents living on your estate, they will be working with us to make sure your concerns about ongoing HS2 works are addressed, and that you are receiving as much support as possible.

In the new year they will be running community meetings and drop-in sessions with residents and businesses. We'll let you know how to contact the team in the next edition of this newsletter.

## Road closures and wayfinding

The section of Stanhope Street between Mackworth Street and Park Village East remains closed in phases for the demolition of the Eskdale building. The footpath will remain open for pedestrians and a diversion will be in place for vehicles. The Thames Water

utility works planned for Eversholt Street have been delayed until mid-January 2020. New pedestrian wayfinding signs have been installed by HS2 on your estate in response to concerns about wayfinding in the area while works are underway. Have these signs helped you to find your way? The demolition of Silverdale, Granby House and Stalbridge House are in progress, with delivery vehicles continuing to enter and leave the site via Granby Terrace Bridge. Demolition of Old Tenant's Hall will begin in January 2020.
