## St. Cross Street, EC1N:

- One-way working, with exemptions for cyclists, to apply with direction of travel from east to west from the junction with Kirby Street to Hatton Garden, and from west to east from the junction with Kirby Street to Saffron Hill.
- Mandatory contraflow cycle lane (direction of travel from east to west) to be designated from the junction with Saffron Hill to a point approximately 4 metres east of the junction with Kirby Street. Revocation of the paid-for parking place and relocation of Car Club parking place to Kirby Street.
- Revocation of single residents parking space opposite no. 21 St. Cross Street and relocation of the adjacent motorcycle parking place eastwards in its place
- 24-hour waiting and loading controls to apply throughout the street except where parking places are designated and for sections on the south side outside nos. 9 and 12 St. Cross Street.

## Kirby Street, EC1N:

- Revocation of single residents parking space outside no. 26 Kirby Street in order to relocate the Car Club parking place from St. Cross Street.
- Designation of 24-hour waiting and loading prohibitions on both sides of the road from the junction with St. Cross Street southwards for approximately 7 metres.


