# Background



- in **April 2023** a new drug and alcohol service will start - the service will replace the 4 separate services we have now

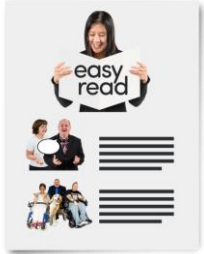


- having 1 service will make it easier for people to find the help and support they need – it also means fewer assessments for people to complete



- Commissioners have worked with CLDS to make sure the new service will meet the needs of people with LD

# Supporting people with learning disabilities



The new service will

- make sure you get the information you need in easy to understand formats
- offer appointment times and locations that work for you
- link in with your existing support workers, carers and family members to help develop good relationships
- work with other services and family carers to set up appointments and reminders – we will ask what support is needed
- change the way we work if needed, to best support people with LD

# Supporting people with learning disabilities



The new service will

- follow advice and guidelines when making changes to our services for people with LD
- offer training about substance misuse to staff in local LD services
- work with LD accommodation services to develop pathways into our service
- work alongside services such as CLDS, Camden Carers and Floating Support providers

# The next steps



- the new service will begin in **April 2023**
- we want service users to have a voice in how the service is run
- there will be lots of opportunities for people to feedback about their experience of using the service – or why they haven't used the service
