

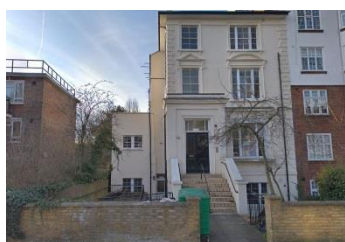
# CLDS Annual Report 2018 - 2019



## Things we did well



- No one had to go into hospital because of mental ill health or behaviour



- We opened Burnet House, a new supported living project for 5 young men with learning disabilities and autism



- We ran groups with people with learning disabilities on

- Most people in supported living or living outside Camden have a Named Social Worker

People with learning disabilities and their families tell us it is better when they have a named worker



- 3 out of 4 adults with a learning disability had an annual health check



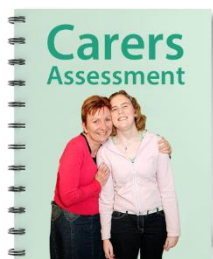
- People are able to see the CLDS specialist health workers when they need to and quickly



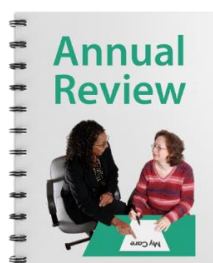
- More people

- have a Direct Payment to give them control over their own care and support



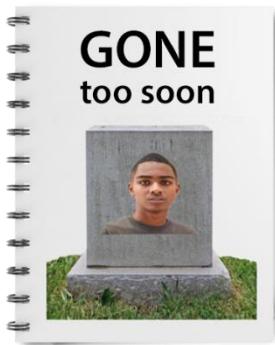
- had a Carers assessment



- had a review of their care and support

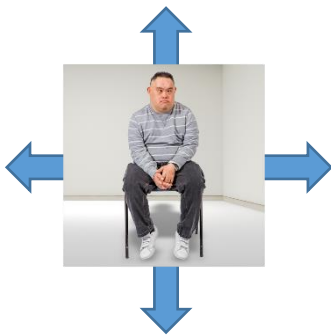


## Things we want to do better

We want to work to support people with their health and wellbeing so they live longer, healthier, happier lives



- We want to support people to be part of their local communities so they feel less lonely



- We are working with Supported Living to help their staff get better at helping people stay healthy



- We are working to make sure more people have health checks



- We want more people with learning disabilities, more family members and more staff to have a flu jab this year



- We want to give the right support at the right time to people who show behaviours of concern, signs of autism or signs of memory difficulties



- We want fewer people to have to take medication because of their behaviour



- We want to hear what people think of CLDS



- We want to ask more people to fill out the CLDS survey



- We want to make it easier for people to get in touch with CLDS



- We want it to be easier to come and see people at CLDS



- Not enough people with learning disabilities have a job

We will work with other teams in the Council and Camden businesses to get more people into work
