

Good Work Camden Disability Job Hub

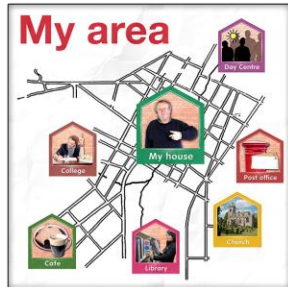

- We help people get a job if they live in Camden and have a disability



- We meet with residents, one to one, at different places in Camden like community centres and libraries



- What we work on with the resident depends on what kind of support they need



- In September the Disability Job Hub paid another organisation to give disability equality training to all Camden Job Hub Staff and other local organisations



- In 2024 they will also give training to employers on Disability Equality



- So far, the Disability Job Hub has started helping more than 35 disabled people in Camden



- Leigh joined the team and she is our Work Ready Coach, helping people with learning disabilities prepare for work



- She will help people with things like:

- Creating a weekly plan
- Finding activities to do
- Travel training
- Confidence building
- Money management
- Skills for the workplace

- Sarah joined the team and she is our Learning Disability Job Hub Advisor, helping people with learning disabilities find a job



- She will help people with things like:
 - Creating a good CV and updating your CV
 - Interview tips and help with job applications
 - Knowing what adjustments you can ask an employer for to help you complete an interview, or to do your job
 - Finding job opportunities with inclusive employers
 - Finding training courses
 - Confidence building

- We started running our 'work for you' drop in sessions at the Greenwood Centre every Wednesday from 10- 12
