What are we responsible for?





Camden Housing

- Housing stock over 33,000 homes
- Over 22,500 tenanted
- Over 9,500 leasehold
- Over 6000 tenants currently listed as needing extra support

Housing Repairs

- 135,000 repair and servicing jobs raised every year
- That's 500 jobs every working day

Enhanced Repairs



- Currently, to be considered for enhanced repairs status, you need to be:
 - 65 or over, live in sheltered housing, or you or someone in your household is getting a care package



- Even if you fit this criteria, we will not complete any repair requests that are the tenant's responsibility
 - The Wishplus handy person service may be able to assist here for a small fee.



- We will always try to prioritise your repair request. If earlier appointments are available we'll bring your appointment forward.
- We understand every situation is different and will always try to support residents who need our help the most.
