

Dumped rubbish

From a few black bags to piles of furniture, rubbish makes areas look unattractive and can quickly get out of control.

What we do

- Each year we collect any dumped rubbish we see, plus over 10,000 incidents reported by you
- We clear 90% of these within 24 hours*
- We issue fines to anyone caught and prosecute people and businesses who dump their rubbish on our streets



What you can do

- See it? • Report it
- Report dumped rubbish free on the Clean Camden app



Bulky rubbish collections

- Free collections of reusable furniture
- Free collections of large electrical items and white goods
- Special collections for large household items to be disposed of

- Add a solar night lighting scheme
