

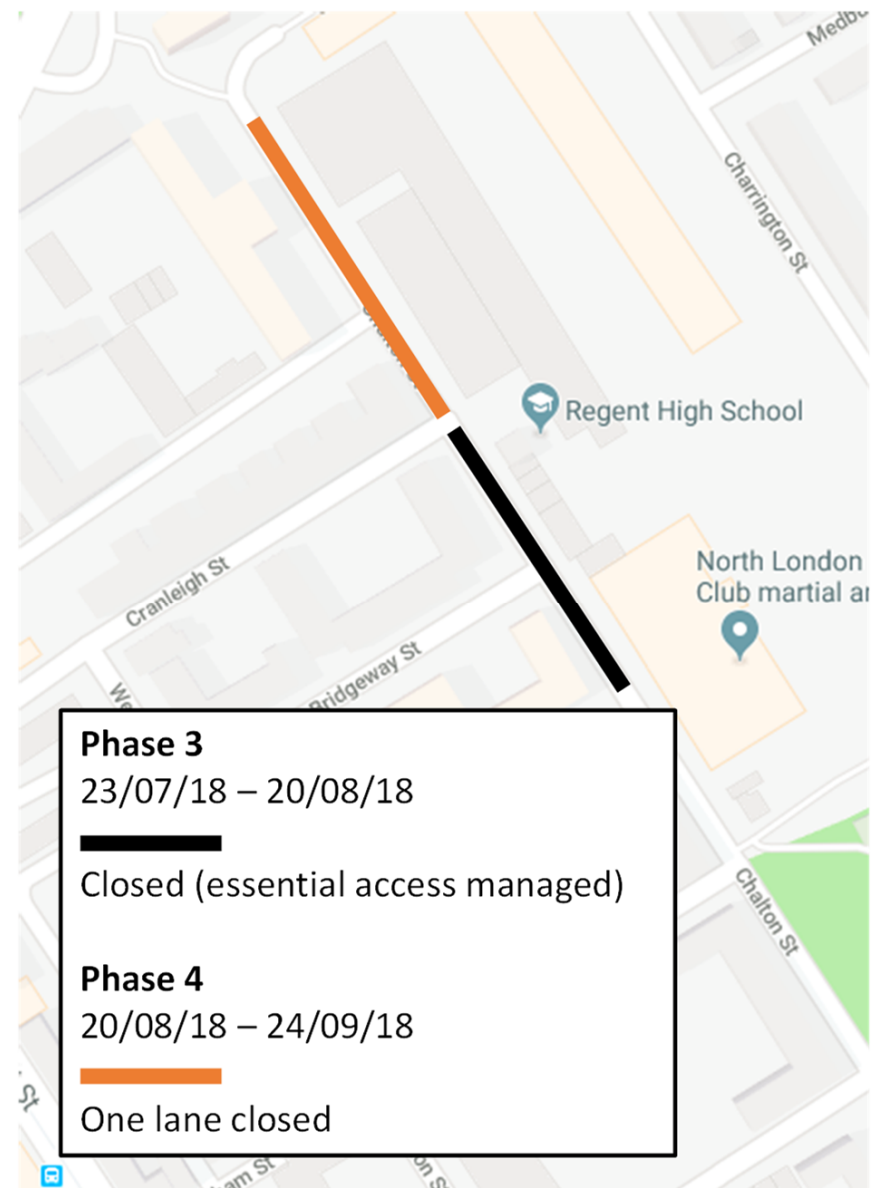
Project Update – July 2018

The final phase of the works will shortly be starting to complete the connection of the Mayford Estate on to the Somers Town Energy network.

Following the first 2 phases of streetworks earlier in the year, the final sections of pipework are to be installed during August and September. Construction works within the Mayford Plant room will also be carried out during this time.

A letter has been sent to you by our contractors explaining all the impacts of the street works. There will be some road diversions and parking suspensions put in place, however access to the estate parking will remain available at all times.

As a reminder, there will be no works required within your flat and the works are being carried out at no cost to tenants or leaseholders. There are no planned disruptions to your heating supply, but should this situation change we will try our best to minimise disruption as much as possible and provide appropriate notice.

Vital Energi will be carrying out the construction work on behalf of London Borough of Camden, and have a 15 year agreement to operate and maintain the network once complete.

Vital Energi will have a permanent site representative who can be found in their site office on Chalton Street.
