

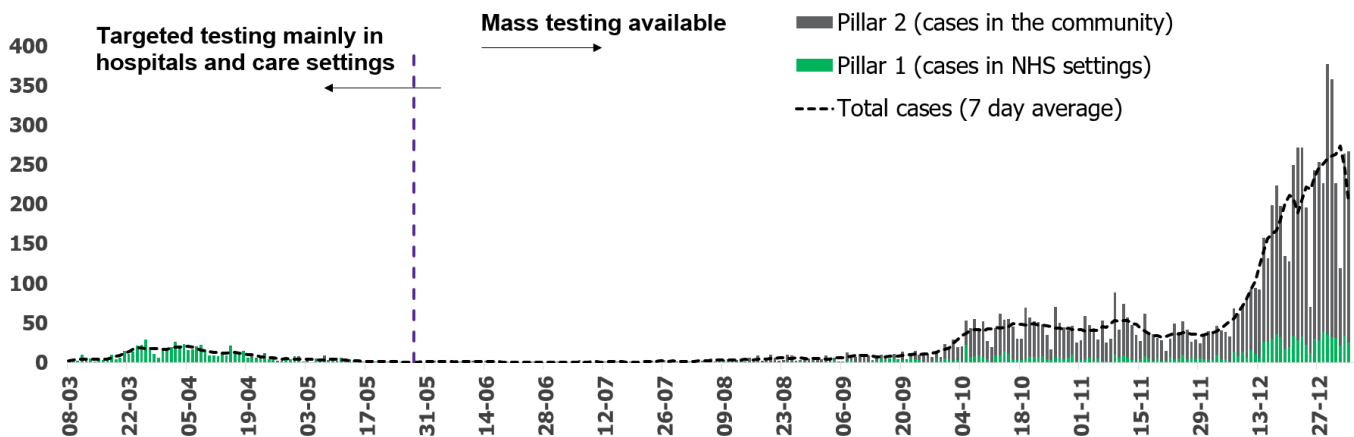
COVID-19 in Camden

Last week (28 December 2020 – 03 January 2021)

New cases per day average **263**

It is important to note that as mass testing wasn't available until 28th May, many cases early on will not have been tested. Therefore, current number of cases cannot be compared to the start of the pandemic.

Camden has had a total of **9,553** confirmed cases, **2%** of London's total.

Weekly incidence rate = 681 per 100,000

Dark red This is lower than London's rate at 1,040.1 per 100,000 and the 5th lowest amongst the 33 London boroughs. This is an increase from last week (576.6) and is rated maroon.


27% of tests are positive

Red For every 100 tests taken 27 on average are coming back positive. A weekly percentage of more than 7.5% is rated red.

These indicators are RAG (red-amber-green) rated to indicate whether they are good or bad.

Green ▲ Amber ● Red ▼
Dark red ◆ Maroon ■

London's R number = 1.2 - 1.5

 This is within the three regions with a higher R number in England. An R number between 1.2 and 1.5 means that on average every 10 people infected will infect between 12 and 15 other people. If the R value is above 1 the pandemic is growing, if it is below 1 the pandemic is shrinking.
