BBQ Rules

Please follow these rules for your own safety and to protect our park



BBQ Safely

- ▶ Only use reusable charcoal BBQs
- ▶ Disposable BBQs are not allowed
- ▶ Only use approved BBQ fuel or firelighters, never use petrol, paraffin or biofuel
- ▶ Bring water to extinguish BBQ after use
- ▶ BBQ only in the designated zones: above the tarmac circle and at a safe distance away from the wooden play area, towards the bottom of the park
- ▶ BBQs elsewhere will be extinguished
- ▶ BBQ only on level ground, well away from trees, paths, flower beds and park furniture
- ▶ Keep children, pets, games and sports at a safe distance from the cooking area
- ▶ Never leave your BBQ unattended

BBQ Responsibly

- ▶ Please be considerate of other park users – no amplified music is allowed
- ▶ Groups of more than 20 people must apply for permission from Camden (apply via [camden.gov.uk/events](https://www.camden.gov.uk/events))
- ▶ Place used BBQ coals – once cool in the metal bins
- ▶ Please take your rubbish home with you and recycle where possible. Otherwise place it bagged into or on top of bins to help stop foxes, squirrels and crows making a mess

Park staff look to ensure the safety of park users and local residents.
If they feel a BBQ is not safe and does not follow these guidelines it will be extinguished.
