Camden Handyperson Service

The handyperson service is available to all residents living in the borough of Camden who are either aged 65 or over, have a health problem or disability (includes households with disabled children), or provide unpaid care for another adult. This service provides minor repairs and handyman-type jobs at a reasonable cost. All our Handypeople are DBS checked.

What type of works can be done?

We can help with a range of minor odd jobs around your property including; minor plumbing jobs, minor electrical jobs, security works, general garden maintenance, small carpentry jobs, changing lightbulbs, draught proofing plus much more.

Please note we are not an emergency call out service and works that are the responsibility of the landlord cannot be carried out by this service.

How much will it cost?

Residents on a low income pay £10 per hour (Rate 1) and households NOT on a low income pay £20 per hour (Rate 2). To qualify for Rate 1 you must provide proof of the benefits you're in receipt of. These fees do not include the cost of materials or congestion charges. Parking charges do not apply. We will provide a maximum of 4 hours work per day and will also provide a FREE 20 minute home security assessment on the day of your appointment.
