The following children's centres and nursery buildings will remain open (Monday to Friday): Regent's Park Children's Centre, Harmood Children's Centre, Agar Children's Centre, Langtry Nursery. They will provide some childcare and offer some midwifery appointments.

Please note the following centres are closed until further notice: 1a Children's Centre, Kilburn Grange Children's Centre (for refurbishment), Hampden Nursery, Konstam Nursery, Gospel Oak Nursery.

Children's Centre drop-ins, courses and activities are temporarily closed until further notice including: health visitor clinics, Bump to Baby antenatal courses, Baby Feeding drop-ins, Family Learning and Stay and Play sessions.
