DARTMOUTH PARK ROAD: revocation of the south-westernmost 6.6 metre section of the residents parking place at the side of no. 1 Grove Terrace.

SWAIN'S LANE: (1) revocation of a 2.6 metre section of the residents parking place at the side of nos. 25 to 36 Langbourne Mansions, (2) revocation of a 2.7 metre section of the residents parking place at the side of nos. 235 to 269 Makepeace Mansions, (3) revocation of a 5.2 metre section of the paid-for parking place at the side of nos. 377 to 408 Holly Lodge Mansions.

Statement of Reasons

There is a growing demand from residents living in high density dwellings, with limited space for sheltered and secure cycle parking within their properties.

A lack of secure cycle hangar storage facilities is currently a barrier to people to cycle. A key objective of the Camden Transport Strategy is to improve cycling facilities for those both living, visiting and working in Camden.

The Council believes the introduction of secure cycle hangar parking facilities would encourage the use of cycling within the borough especially in locations where high density dwellings are present.

The following locations have been identified as a suitable for the installation secure cycle hangar parking units:

- 1. Swains Lane nr. Oakeshott Avenue 2 Hangars
- 2. Swains Lane nr. Makepeace Avenue 1 Hangar
- 3. Swains Lane nr. Langbourne Avenue 1 Hangar
- 4. Dartmouth Park Road 2 Hangars
- 5. Great James Street 1 Hangar

1. Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order shall come into force on and may be cited as The Camden (Revocation of Parking Places) (No. 5) Traffic Order 2020.

2. Interpretation

- In this order, the following terms have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - "CA-U order" means the Camden (Parking Places) (CA-U) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C. 2012 No. 18];
 - "Dedicated Disabled order" means the Camden (Parking Places) (Dedicated Disabled) Traffic Order 2020 [L.B.C. 2012 No. 23];
- Any reference in this order to any other order or enactment shall be construed as a reference to that order or enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent order or enactment.
- Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this order which is also used in the parent order shall have the same meaning as in that order.

3. Revocation and designation of parking places

- Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this order;
- 3.1.1 the CA-U order shall have effect as though;
- there was omitted from schedule 1 to that order, the items set out in table 1.1 of the schedule to this order;

- there was included in schedule 1 to that order, the items set out in table 1.2 of the schedule to this order;

- the Dedicated Disabled order shall have effect as though there was omitted from the schedule to that order, the item set out in table 2 of the schedule to this order.
