Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden made the above mentioned order on 14 September 2020 under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The order will come into force on 24 September 2020. The general nature and effect of the order is set out below:

In order to facilitate the construction of cycle lanes on either side of the carriageway in Gray's Inn Road, changes to waiting and loading restrictions and the designation of parking places are necessary both in Gray's Inn Road between its junctions with Harrison Street and High Holborn and in nearby streets.

GRAY'S INN ROAD:

All parking places to be removed from Gray's Inn Road with relocations to neighbouring streets as below: Car Club (2 spaces) outside no. 222 Gray's Inn Road – relocated to Gough Street;

Paid-for (3 spaces) outside no. 222 Gray's Inn Road – 2 spaces relocated to Gough Street, 1 space relocated to North Mews;

Paid-for (2 spaces) outside no. 190 Gray's Inn Road – relocated to Gough Street;

Disabled persons' (Blue Badge) (2 spaces) outside nos. 77-79 Gray's Inn Road – relocated to Roger Street Car Club (2 spaces) outside nos. 73-75 Gray's Inn Road – relocated to Coley Street

Market traders' (4 spaces) outside no. 70 Gray's Inn Road, (3 spaces) outside no. 60 Gray's Inn Road, (6 spaces) outside nos. 10-11 Gray's Inn Road, (2 spaces) outside no. 1 to 23 Gray's Inn Road, (3 spaces) outside no. 1 to 23 Gray's Inn Road – are all revoked. Market traders' using the bays detailed above may be relocated to other bays in the area and new Market Traders' parking places are designated as detailed below.

Waiting and Loading restrictions in Gray's Inn Road

In general, a 24-hour waiting prohibition, including for the purposes of loading / unloading is designated in Gray's Inn Road from the junction with Harrison Street to the junction with High Holborn. Excepted areas are a 40 metre section on the east side outside nos. 14 to 22 and no. 24 Gray's Inn Road, a 16.4 metre section on the west side outside nos. 39 to 45 Gray's Inn road and a 13.9 metres section on the east side opposite nos. 39 to 45 Gray's Inn Road where no prohibition on loading applies.

HARRISON STREET

Doctors' parking place opposite Tangere (3 spaces) revoked and replaced with 2 paid-for parking spaces and 1 Car Club space

Motorcycle parking place at the side of no. 233 to 241 Gray's Inn Road to be relocated to the opposite side of the road outside Tangere

FREDERICK STREET

Car Club (1 space) and paid-for (2 spaces) parking places to be removed and relocated to Harrison Street as detailed above

CUBITT STREET

Residents permit holders parking place (2 spaces) designated opposite no. 65 Cubitt Street.

A contiguous 24-hour waiting prohibition, including for the purposes of loading / unloading will be designated in Frederick Street and Cubitt Street (south and east sides respectively) from outside no. 1 Frederick Street to a point in Cubitt Street 12 metres south of the junction with Frederick Street.

AMPTON STREET

Section of the residents permit holders parking place (2 spaces) outside nos. 32-36 Ampton Street to be removed and relocated to Cubitt Street as detailed above

GOUGH STREET

3 paid-for parking places, two consisting of 1 space and one of 2 spaces designated at the rear of nos. 222 and 236 Gray's Inn Road – relocated from Gray's Inn Road as detailed above

Car Club parking place (2 spaces) designated at the rear of no. 222 Gray's Inn Road – relocated from Gray's Inn road as detailed above

Motorcycle parking place at the rear of no. 200 Gray's Inn road revoked and replaced with a paid-for parking place (2 spaces) – relocated from Roger Street as detailed below

COLEY STREET

Car Club parking place (2 spaces) designated at the side of no. 222 Gray's Inn Road – relocated from Gray's Inn Road as detailed above

ROGER STREET

Doctors' parking place (2 spaces) at the side of nos. 81 and 81B Gray's Inn Road relocated to North Mews as detailed below and replaced with disabled persons' parking place (2 spaces) – relocated from Gray's Inn Road as detailed above

Paid-for parking place (2 spaces) outside nos. 14-16 Roger Street removed and relocated to Gough Street as detailed above

NORTH MEWS

Paid-for parking place (1 space) and Doctors' Parking Place (2 spaces) designated at the side of no. 12 Roger Street. Paid-for space relocated from Gray's Inn road and Doctors parking spaces relocated from Roger Street as detailed above

ELM STREET

Resident permit holders parking place (1 space) at the side of nos. 30 to 50 Gray's Inn Road removed and relocated outside Elm House in replacing the doctors' parking place.

Market traders' parking place (also for use by resident permit "CA-D" holders on Saturdays) designated outside Elm House

WARNER STREET

Market traders' parking place (1 space, also for use by resident permit "CA-D" holders on Saturdays) to the east of Warner Yard designated in place of a business permit holders parking place – relocated from Gray's Inn Road as detailed above

RAY STREET

Market traders' parking place opposite the Coach P.H. revoked.

NORTHINGTON STREET

Residents permit holders parking place (2 spaces) at the side of no. 59 Gray's Inn Road relocated 10 metres eastwards.

HATTON WALL

Market traders' parking place (3 spaces, also for use by residents' permit "CA-D" holders on Saturdays) designated opposite nos. 12-16 Hatton Wall.

BALDWIN'S GARDENS

Motorcycle parking place at the side of no. 46 Gray's Inn Road relocated eastwards to the side of no. 7 Brooke's Court

GREVILLE STREET

Parking places on the south side of the street outside nos. 20 - 23 and no. 24 Greville Street to be relocated to the opposite side of the street and replaced with a 24-hour waiting prohibition, including for the purposes of loading / unloading

BEDFORD ROW

Westernmost section of the 2-space Car Club parking place outside no . 49 to 51 Bedford Row to be replaced with a Market trader's parking space (also for use by resident permit "CA-D" holders on Saturdays) – relocated from Gray's Inn Road as detailed above.

PORTPOOL LANE

Car Club parking place (1 space) at the side of no. 70 Gray's Inn Road is revoked

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months beginning with the date on which the experimental orders come into force or, if the orders are varied by other orders or modified pursuant to section 10 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation.

Any such objection must be made in writing, stating the grounds on which the objection is being made and sent to safetravel@camden.gov.uk or by post to FREEPOST LBC Transport Strategy. Copies of the orders and other documents related to these schemes may be inspected at camden.gov.uk/recently-advertised-proposals or by contacting traffic.orders@camden.gov.uk or at London Borough of Camden, 5 Pancras Square, N1C 4AG.

Notice is also given under s.23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 of the Council's intention to adjust pedestrian crossings in Gray's Inn Road outside nos. 252b and 252c (controlled area extended by approximately 4 metres southwards), outside no. 200 (crossing point and controlled area moved approximately 5 metres southwards), immediately south of Elm Street (crossing point moved approximately 5 metres northwards and controlled area extended northwards to the north side of the junction with Elm Street). These and the crossing located immediately north of Baldwin's Gardens will also facilitate crossing by cyclists.

The order has been made to facilitate the construction of cycle lanes either side of the carriageway in Gray's Inn Road by revoking parking places in this street and re-allocating them, where appropriate, to neighbouring streets. In addition, 24-hour waiting restrictions, including for the purposes of loading or unloading are designated in general along Gray's Inn Road excepting some areas where a ban on loading will not be in force.





REASONS FOR PROCEEDING BY WAY OF AN EXPERIMENT


At the present time, restrictions on people's movements as a result of the Covid-19 crisis may render normal modes of consultation ineffective. Additionally, the current state of traffic on the affected streets may not reflect the ordinary operation of the schemes which may prevent consultees from forming a reasoned opinion over their effect.


The experimental order will be in force for a maximum period of 18 months and the council will decide whether or not to retain the schemes indefinitely before the expiration of this period. The council is required to consider any objections made over the initial 6 month period. It is anticipated that the various schemes may have a longer-term utility and their operation will be evaluated whilst the experimental orders remain in force. Council officers would ideally wish to carry out a full consultation on each scheme after 12 months to elicit views from stakeholders and members of the public, subject to circumstances. A decision as to whether to do so or not will be made nearer the time.


















































Made on 14 September 2020

Coming into force on 24 September 2020

The Council of the London Borough of Camden, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and part IV of schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 [1984 c. 27], as amended by section 8 of and part I of schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 [1985 c. 51], and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following order:

1. Citation and commencement

This Order shall come into force on 24 September 2020 and may be cited as The Camden (Gray's Inn Road and Side Streets) Experimental Traffic Order 2020.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1 In this order, the following terms have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - "CA-D order" means the Camden (Parking Places) (CA-D) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C. 2012 No. 4];
 - "Car Club order" means the Camden (Parking Places) (Car Clubs) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C 2012 No. 26];
 - "Disabled Persons' order" means the Camden (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) Traffic Order 2012; [L.B.C. 2012 No. 22];
 - "Doctors' order" means the Camden (Parking Places) (Doctors) Traffic Order 2012; [L.B.C. 2012 No. 27];
 - "Market Traders' order" means the Camden (Parking Places) (Market Traders) Traffic Order 2012; [L.B.C. 2012 No. 30];
 - "Business Scheme 'A' order" means the Camden (Parking Places) (Business Scheme 'A') Traffic Order 2012; [L.B.C.2012 No. 25];
 - "Waiting and Loading order" means the Camden (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Civil Enforcement Area) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C. 2012 No. 1];
- Any reference in this order to any other order or enactment shall be construed as a reference to that order or enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent order or enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 (2) of the Act of 1984, the Director of Regeneration & Planning, Supporting Communities Directorate, or any person authorised by him may, if it appears to him or such other authorised person essential in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or in the provision of suitable and adequate parking, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this order runs, modify or suspend this order or any of the provisions in this order.
