Notice is also given under s.23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and s.90A of the Highways Act 1980 of the council's intention to introduce a raised zebra crossing in Camley Street using a flat-top road hump. The zebra crossing controlled area will extend 38 metres with the crossing point approximately 15 metres south-east of the south-eastern building wall of no. 103a Camley Street. 

Statement of Reasons

There has been an increased amount of pedestrian activity in Camley Street following recent building development in the area. Pedestrians, parents and the Kings Cross Academy have raised road safety concerns regarding parked vehicles across the single yellow lines making it difficult to cross at this location. Therefore a zebra crossing will be established together with 24-hour waiting restrictions on its approach.

1. Citation and commencement

2. Interpretation

- 2.1.1 the term "parent order" means the Camden (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Civil Enforcement Area) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C 2012 No. 1];
- 2.1.2 any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;
- 2.1.3 unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this order which is also used in the parent order shall have the same meaning as in that order.

3. Amendment to schedule 1 to the parent order

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this order the parent order shall have effect as though there was substituted for the items set out in relation to the similarly named streets in schedule 1 to the parent order, the items set out in the table of the schedule to this order;
