Permanent (i.e. 24 hours a day) waiting and loading prohibitions to be designated in both streets on the north side for a distance of approximately 15 metres from the junction with Kentish Town Road with the affected disabled parking place in Patshull Road and paid-for parking spaces in both streets to be relocated with 5 metre sections of the permit holders parking places outside nos.5-7 Gaisford Street and nos. 4-6 Patshull Road converted for this purpose.

MORNINGTON TERRACE, MORNINGTON STREET, NW1

Contraflow cycling (i.e. in a north to south direction) to be permitted along the entire length of Mornington Terrace. Cyclists will also be exempt from the banned left / right-turns into Mornington Terrace at the junction with Mornington Street. Permanent waiting and loading restrictions to be designated on all arms of the junctions with Mornington Street and Mornington Place. A 15 metre section of the residents permit holders parking place on the south-west side of Mornington Terrace, opposite nos. 8-10, will be removed and replaced with a permanent waiting and loading prohibition. The permit holders parking place on the north-east side of Mornington Terrace between the junctions with Mornington Place and Mornington Street will be extended by 15 metres at the north-western extremity.

CHETWYND ROAD, DARTMOUTH PARK ROAD, GROVE END, GROVE TERRACE; NW5

Removal of permit holders parking places at the south-eastern end of Grove End (4.1m length) and on the north-western side of Dartmouth Park Road opposite the junction with Grove End (7.5m length). Designation of permanent waiting and loading prohibitions at the south-western ends of Grove Terrace and the north-west side of Dartmouth Park Road and at the south-western end of Grove End and the north-west side Chetwynd Road where these streets meet.
