**JEFFREY'S STREET -** cyclists are permitted to turn right from Jeffrey's Street into Royal College Street.

**WILKIN STREET -** designation of a 24-hour waiting restriction in Wilkin Street from its junction with Talacre Road eastwards to the entrance to Priestly House, excepting the permit holders parking place near to the junction with Talacre Road.



- In this order the term "pedal cycle" has the same meaning ascribed to them by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 [S.I. 2016 No. 326].

#### 4. Restrictions

No person shall cause any vehicle to turn right from Jeffrey's Street into Royal College Street.

#### 5. Exemptions

- Nothing in Article 4 shall apply in respect of;
- 5.1.1 anything done with the permission of a police constable or traffic warden in uniform:
- a vehicle being used by the police, ambulance service or fire brigade in an emergency;

- any person causing any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 5.1.4 a pedal cycle.


