Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden proposes to make the above Orders under Sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The general nature and effect of the order is set out below.

MALDEN CRESCENT: revoke the residents parking place opposite nos. 15-28 Forge Place (approximately 45m length); convert the paid-for parking place outside 205/207 Denton to a residents parking place and extend at each end to accommodate an additional parking space

FERDINAND STREET: convert the paid-for parking place outside Rugmere to a residents parking place (approximately 3 car spaces)

FERDINAND PLACE: designate a paid-for parking space (approx. 5m length) approximately 15 metres south of the cul-de-sac end of the street


STATEMENT OF REASONS


In order to provide standing space for buses displaced from the Camden Goods Yard redevelopment site whilst building works take place, the permit holders parking place opposite the rear of Forge Place will be revoked and replaced with a bus stand.

Residents parking will be re-provided by converting paid-for bays nearby to permit holders parking bays. A paid-for parking space will also be provided in Ferdinand Place.

The intention of the council is to revoke this order once development work is completed to the extent that the bus stand can be returned to the Camden Goods Yard site.







1. Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order shall come into force on and may be cited as The Camden (Parking Places) (CA-F) (Amendment No. 24) Traffic Order 2021.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1 In this order:
- 2.1.1 the term "parent order" means the Camden (Parking Places) (CA-F) (Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C 2012 No. 6];
- 2.1.2 any reference in this order to any other order or enactment shall be construed as a reference to that order or enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, reenacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent order or enactment;
- 2.1.3 unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this order which is also used in the parent order shall have the same meaning as in that order.

3. Revocation and designation of parking places

- 3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this order the parent order shall have effect as though:
- 3.1.1 there was omitted from schedule 1 to the parent order, the items set out in table 1 of the schedule to this order;
- 3.1.2 there was included in schedule 1 to the parent order, the items set out in table 2 of the schedule to this order;
- 3.1.3 there was omitted from schedule 2 to the parent order, the items set out in table 3 of the schedule to this order;

3.1.4 there was included in schedule 2 to the parent order, the items set out in table 4 of the schedule to this order;
