

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The extension of an existing dedicated disabled parking bay outside 77 College Place will be one metre to a length of 7.5 metres. This is to allow more space to the north of this bay to facilitate access to a proposed dropped kerb to be used for a mobility scooter.

Also, it will reduce the chances of other vehicles overhanging into the disabled parking bay thus preventing the disabled person accessing the vehicle's rear to access the mobility scooter.

The repositioning of both disabled parking and resident permit parking signposts are to remove blockage access to vehicles caused by cycles being locked to them.
