Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden made the above mentioned orders on 31 August 2021 under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The modifying orders will come into force on 9 September 2021. The general nature and effect of the orders will be to modify the Camden (Islip Street, Hammond Street) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 and the Camden (Polygon Road) Traffic Order 2021 which both came into force on 24 June 2021 as set out below:

The Camden (Islip Street, Hammond Street) (Modification No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 – motor vehicles may not proceed in a northwards direction in Hammond Street past a point lying approximately 41 metres south of its junction with Islip Street. The restriction applies at all times. Motor vehicles may proceed southwards past this point. The restrictions on motor vehicles entering the section of Islip Street between the eastern kerb line of Frideswide Place and the eastern kerb line of Hammond Street between 8.15 and 9.15am and between 3 and 4pm on Mondays to Fridays during Kentish Town Primary School term times is unaffected by this modification.

The Camden (Polygon Road) (Modification No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 – the modification corrects a drafing error in the Camden (Polygon Road) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 to specify that the restrictions on motor vehicle entry in Polygon Road applies between the junctions with Werrington Street and Chalton Street between 8.30 and 9.30am and between 3 and 4pm, as was notified in the Notice of Making of that order published on 17 June 2021.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental orders should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months beginning with the date on which the experimental orders come into force or, if the orders are varied by other orders or modified pursuant to section 10 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation. Any such objection must be made in writing, stating the grounds on which the objection is being made and sent to safetravel@camden.gov.uk or by post to FREEPOST LBC Transport Strategy. 
