TOWER STREET – conversion of the bicycle hire parking place outside nos. 4-10 Tower Street to a residents' permit holders parking space, extending the adjacent residents' permit holders parking place by approximately 5.4 metres. Conversion of the south-easternmost 5.4 metre section of the residents' permit holders parking place, and the north-westernmost 1.8 metre section of the motorcycle parking place at the junction with Tower Court to a bicycle hire parking place. These proposals to relocate the bicycle hire parking place from the north-western end of Tower Street supersede those published on 20 October 2022.

SANDLAND STREET – north side: conversion of the paid-for parking place outside nos. 20-22 Sandland Street, approximately 26 metres length, to a resident permit holders parking place. **MANSFIELD ROAD** – north side: conversion of the easternmost 6.6 metres section of the resident permit holders' parking place outside nos. 48 and 50 Mansfield Road to a dedicated disabled person's parking place.

LITHOS ROAD – south-east side: conversion of a 6.6 metre section of the permit holders' parking place outside nos. 13 and 15 Lithos Road to a dedicated disabled person's parking place.

BELSIZE ROAD – north side: conversion of the westernmost 10 metre section of the permit holders' parking place opposite nos. 113 and 115 Belsize Road to a doctors permit holders parking place.

ESTELLE ROAD / SAVERNAKE ROAD - revocation of the residents permit holders parking place outside nos. 45-61 Estelle Road; designation of 24-hour waiting and loading restrictions on both sides of Estelle Road from the junction with Savernake Road south-eastwards for a distance of approximately 10 metres, and on the south side of Savernake Road westwards from the junction with Estelle Road for a distance of approximately 10 metres and eastwards from the same junction for a distance of approximately 7 metres

Statement of Reasons

Disabled Parking Places - Lithos Road, Mansfield Road

The orders will designate (or revoke where they are no longer required) parking places either for the sole use of residents whose mobility is severely impaired or for the leaving of vehicles in which a valid Blue Badge is displayed.

The proposals meet the objectives of Camden Transport Strategy (CTS) which acknowledges that people who have a disability can have particular difficulties when they are travelling by public transport, and walking and cycling may be difficult, unsuitable, or simply not an option.

Relocation of bicycle hire bay - Tower Street


Over the last two years the borough has implemented a network of nearly two hundred parking bays to support micro mobility in the form of hire E-Bikes and rental E-Scooters as part of the London Rental E-scooter trial. These new modes of transport have enabled people who live and work in the borough to have greater options in how they travel. The bay on Tower Street is one of the busiest locations for these modes of transport. As usage of these modes of transport increases and demand for the parking bays grows, we have seen capacity issues and a small amount of disruption in regard to the bay at the north-western end of Tower Street. At busier times this bay has seen hire vehicles overflowing into surrounding parking bays and the street due to the existing bay being full. This consultation concerns proposals to solve the issues mentioned above by relocating the bay to the south-eastern end of Tower Street to meet demand.


Designation of doctors parking place - Belsize Road


In Camden limited kerbside space and high parking occupancy rates has resulted in various types of dedicated parking bays. These include Doctor's parking bays to support legal medics carry out a quick response to emergency call outs. Legal medics include a qualified general practitioner (GP) or a Hospital Consultant with their own list of patients, or an assistant or trainee GP. The Doctor's bay enable's a doctor with emergency commitments to park their vehicle within a reasonable distance of their surgery or consulting room.


Minor parking restriction changes - Estelle Road, Savernake Road


The proposals would designate additional waiting restrictions at the junction of these two streets in order to prevent parking by vehicles at all times, including for the purposes of loading and unloading, thereby improving sightlines for the benefit of pedestrians and vehicle users alike. A single-space residents parking place would also be revoked for the same reasons.



The Council of the London Borough of Camden, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and part IV of schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 [1984 c. 27], as amended by section 8 of and part I of schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985 [1985 c. 51], and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following order:

1. Citation and commencement

This order shall come into force on and may be cited as the Camden (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 153) Traffic Order 2023.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1 In this order;
- the term "parent order" means the Camden (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Civil Enforcement Area) Traffic Order 2012 [L.B.C 2012 No. 1];
- any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;
- unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this order which is also used in the parent order shall have the same meaning as in that order.

3. Amendments to Schedule 1, 2 and 5 to the parent order

- Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this order the parent order shall have effect as though;
- there was substituted for items set out in relation to similarly named streets in schedule 1 to that order, the items set out in table 1 of the schedule to this order;
- there was substituted for items set out in relation to similarly named streets in schedule 2 to that order, the items set out in table 2 of the schedule to this order.
