REGENT'S PARK ROAD – conversion of the easternmost 6.6 metre section of the residents permit holders parking place outside no. 208 Regent's Park Road to a dedicated disabled person's parking place.

THE MOUNT SQUARE – removal of the residents permit holders parking place outside nos. 15 and 16 The Mount Square (approximately 6.6 metres length) with a prohibition on waiting by vehicles applying at all times to be designated at the location.






The purpose of this proposal is to:
