Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Camden ('the Council') propose to make the above Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The general nature and effect of the Orders is as set out below:

Removal of on-street parking and introduction of 'at any time' waiting restrictions to improve access to premises:

Aldred Road – removal of a 1 metre section of 'paid-for' parking place on the south-west side at its junction with Orestes Mews, and introduction of 'at any time' waiting restrictions extending for a distance of 12.7 metres across the entrance to Orestes Mews:

Modbury Gardens – removal of a 12.8 metre section of 'CA-L' permit holders parking place on the south side outside Nos. 1-2 Modbury Gardens, and introduction of 'at any time' waiting restrictions (i) on the north side, extending for a distance of 26.8 metres outside Nos. 11-14 Modbury Gardens: and (ii) on the south side, extending for a distance of 26.8 metres outside Nos. 1-4 Modbury Gardens.

The above measures are intended to deter obstructive parking and improve vehicular access, especially access for emergency services vehicles, to premises in Orestes Mews and Modbury Gardens.

Provision of 'dedicated disabled' parking places:

Gondar Gardens – conversion of a 6.6 metre section of 'CA-P' permit holders parking place on the south-east side outside No. 42 Gondar Gardens, to a 'dedicated disabled' parking place: Lancaster Grove - conversion of a 6.6 metre section of 'CA-B' permit holders parking place on the south-west side outside No. 6 Lancaster Grove, to a 'dedicated disabled' parking place:

Oseney Crescent - conversion of a 6.6 metre section of 'CA-M' permit holders parking place on the north-west side outside No. 19 Osenev Crescent, to a 'dedicated disabled' parking place: Park Village East – conversion of an existing 'CA-G' resident permit holders parking place and 0.65 metres of 'single yellow line' waiting restrictions on the south-west side, outside 'Cubitt Court', No. 100 Park Village East, to a 'dedicated disabled' parking place, 6.6 metres in length;

Varndell Street – conversion of a 6.5 metre section of 'single vellow line' waiting restrictions on the south side adjacent to 'The Tarns', to a 'dedicated disabled' parking place'.

Each 'dedicated disabled' parking place would operate at any time and be reserved for the use of a specific disabled resident.

Provision of disabled persons 'blue badge' parking places:

Goldhurst Terrace – conversion of a 6.6 metre section of 'CA-R' permit holders parking place on the north-west side, outside No. 96 Goldhurst Terrace, to a disabled persons 'blue badge' parking place:

Ospringe Road - conversion of a 6.6 metre section of 'CA-M' permit holders parking place on the north side, outside Nos. 2-4 Ospringe Road, to a disabled persons 'blue badge' parking place. Each disabled persons 'blue badge' parking place would operate at any time and may be used by any vehicle displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge'.

Conversion of 'dedicated disabled' parking places to disabled persons 'blue badge' parking:

Albert Street - conversion of a 3.2 metres (standing at an angle of 90° to the kerb) 'dedicated disabled' parking place on the north-east side, outside No. 28 Albert Street, to a disabled persons 'blue badge' parking place;

Belsize Park - conversion of a 6.6 metres 'dedicated disabled' parking place on the north-west side, outside No. 48 Belsize Park, to a disabled persons 'blue badge' parking place;

Castle Road - conversion of a 6.5 metres 'dedicated disabled' parking place on the north side, outside No. 4 Castle Road, to a disabled persons 'blue badge' parking place;

Downshire Hill - conversion of a 6.6 metres 'dedicated disabled' parking place on the south-east side, outside No. 52 Downshire Hill, to a disabled persons 'blue badge' parking place.

The above measures are proposed where a 'dedicated disabled' parking place is no longer required for a specific resident, but the Council wishes to retain a general parking facility for

disabled road users in that location.

Conversion of disabled parking places to permit holders parking:

Goldhurst Terrace – conversion of a 6.6 metres 'dedicated disabled' parking place on the northwest side, outside Nos. 172-174 Goldhurst Terrace, to 'CA-R' permit holders parking; **Solent Road** – conversion of a 6.6 metres 'dedicated disabled' parking place on the north-east side, outside Nos. 68-70 Solent Road, to 'CA-P' permit holders parking.

Aldred Road/Orestes Mews— removal of a 1 metre section of 'paid-for' parking place on the south-west side at its junction with Orestes Mews, and introduction of 'at any time' waiting restrictions extending for a distance of 12.7 metres across the entrance to Orestes Mews;

Modbury Gardens – removal of a 12.8 metre section of 'CA-L' permit holders parking place on the south side outside Nos. 1-2 Modbury Gardens, and introduction of 'at any time' waiting restrictions (i) on the north side, extending for a distance of 26.8 metres outside Nos. 11-14 Modbury Gardens; and (ii) on the south side, extending for a distance of 26.8 metres outside Nos. 1-4 Modbury Gardens.

Disabled persons parking places:

Albert Street, NW1, Parking Changes - The purpose of this proposal is to convert the existing dedicated disabled bay outside No 30 Albert Street, which has been notified as no longer required, to a general disabled bay for use by any blue badge holders.

Belsize Park, NW3, Parking Changes -The purpose of this proposal is to convert the existing dedicated disabled bay outside No 48 Belsize Park, which has been notified as no longer required, to a general disabled bay for use by any blue badge holders.

Castle Road, NW1, Parking Changes - The purpose of this proposal is to convert the existing dedicated disabled bay outside No 4 Castle Rd, which has been notified as no longer required, to a general disabled bay for use by any blue badge holders.

Oseney Crescent, NW6 Parking Changes - The purpose of this proposal is to convert 6.6 metres of resident permit holder (CPZ CA-P) parking to dedicated disabled parking bay outside 19 Oseney Crescent, for the applicants sole use.

Downshire Hill, NW3, Parking Changes - The purpose of this proposal is to convert the existing dedicated disabled bay outside No 52 Downshire Hill, which has been notified as no longer required, to a general disabled bay for use by any blue badge holders.

Goldhurst Terrace, NW6, Parking Changes - The purpose of this proposal is to:

- convert the existing dedicated disabled bay outside No 172 Goldhurst Terrace, which has been notified as no longer required, to a resident permit holder space (CPZ CA-R/K).
- convert 6.6 metres of resident permit holder (CPZ CA-R/K) parking space to general disabled parking bay outside 96 Goldhurst Terrace, for use by any blue badge holders.

Gondar Gardens, NW6, Parking Changes - The purpose of this proposal is to convert 6.6 metres of resident permit holder (CPZ CA-P) parking bay to dedicated disabled parking bay outside 42 Gondar Gardens, for the sole use of the applicant.




CONVERSION OF EXISTING DEDICATED DISABLED BAY TO GENERAL DISABLED BAY


