TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1988

ARTICLE 4 DIRECTION: 13-51 (ODD) AND 16-60 (EVEN)

BELSIZE AVENUE LONDON NW3

WHEREAS:

1. The Council of the London Borough of Camden (hereinafter called "the Council") is the Local Planning Authority for the said Borough within the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 as amended.
2. The Council is satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of the amenity of the area that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be undertaken on land at 13-51 (odd) and 16-60 (even) Belsize Avenue, London NW3 such land being shown for the purpose of identification only edged in red on the plan annexed hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") unless permission therefore is granted on an application in that behalf.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 and all other powers enabling it in that behalf **HEREBY DIRECTS** that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order of 1988 shall not apply to development of the description specified in the Schedule hereto in on over or under the land or any part or parts thereof.

**THIS DIRECTION** may be cited as the London Borough of Camden Town and Country Planning Article 4 Direction No. 2 1994

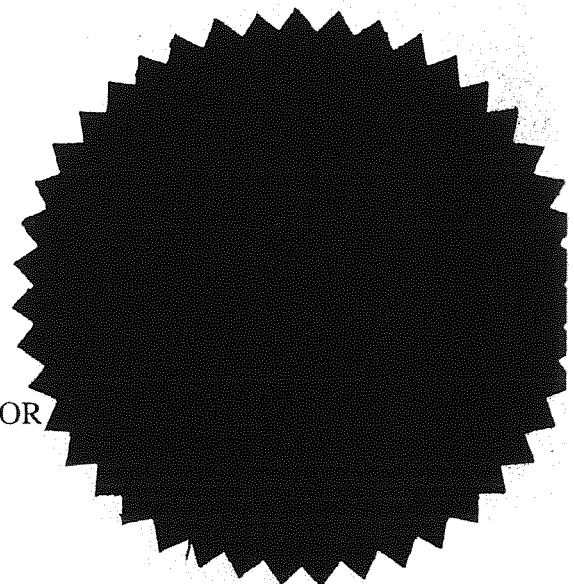
Development comprised within the undermentioned Part of the Second Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988

Part 1: Class F: The provision within the curtilage of a dwellinghouse of a hard surface for any purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwellinghouse as such.
