name of parent/guardian, emergency contact number, relationship to the trainee, child's year group at school, helmet preference.

Equalities monitoring (optional) ethnicity, disability, gender

Recipients that the Council has or will disclose the data to.

Camden Transport Strategy Service may contact those participants who have opted in with offers of information or invitations for feedback on measures which affect cycling, such as new cycleways, cycle parking or traffic calming.

Participants' data will not be shared with anyone else.

We also undertake general data matching or data sharing in certain areas for the prevention or detection of crime, you can find out more information on that here

We will not transfer your personal data outside the UK.

Personal data will be retained for four years and then deleted.
