

Camden Enhanced Offer

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Camden Enhanced Offer you must:

- be a resident of London Borough of Camden
- not be eligible for the Government's 30 hours free childcare for working parents (eligibility criteria outlined at www.childcarechoices.gov.uk)
- take your universal entitlement of 15 hours free childcare in Camden

You must also meet one of the following criteria:

- your family receives Universal Credit and your annual household income after tax is £15,400 or less, not including benefit payments
- you receive Income Support, an income-based Jobseeker's Allowance or an income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- your family receives working tax credits and your annual household income before tax is £16,190 or less
- you receive the Guaranteed Credit component of Pension Credit
- you qualify for a 'four week run-on' of tax credit payments after no longer qualifying for the Working Tax Credit
- your child is being 'looked after' by the local authority or is a child who has 'left care'*
- your child has a statement of special educational needs (SEN) or an Education, Health and Care Plan*
- you receive a disability living allowance for your child*
- you receive support from the National Asylum Support Service (NASS) through part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act

* evidence must be provided with application
