

A PARTICIPATORY DESIGN PROJECT

TO CREATE A DESIGN VISION FOR GOOD HELP FOR FAMILIES AFTER COVID

CO-CREATED BY AN EXPERT GROUP OF PARENTS AND FAMILY MEMBERS FROM CAMDEN

AND THE SERVICE DESIGN MASTERS STUDENTS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF THE ARTS LONDON

TO INFORM CAMDEN COVID RECOVERY PLANS, STRATEGIES AND SERVICES

What do we mean when we say participatory design?

Design <u>Iustice</u> is what love looks like in public spaces.

Design should be a deep expression of care of a beloved community expressed in physical form.

Family Changemakers is a co-design project based on three principles


Deliberative Dialogue

Using consensus-building techniques, enabling participants to work together to develop an agreed view or set of recommendations. Participants take their recommendations forward to decision-makers.

Participatory Design

A democratic process for design of systems involving human work, where users are involved in designs they will be using, and that all stakeholders, including and especially users, have equal input into the design process.






What have the students done so far on the design question of how can we make it as easy as possible for Camden families to find help as early in the life of problems as possible after COVID?

How can we make sure the help feels good no matter who gives it'?












The Importance of Synthesis!




This step often informs what designers can design and how policy makers can understand the data as they often won't be the ones to interact with the users.


