The orders will come into force on 24 June 2021. The general nature and effect of the orders will be to introduce prohibitions on entry by motor vehicles will be introduced at the locations specified below together with changes to parking restrictions as mentioned. All restrictions apply during school term times only.

The Camden (Polygon Road) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 – motor vehicles are prohibited from entering the section of Polygon Road between its junctions with Werrington Street and Chalton Street on Mondays to Fridays between 8.30 and 9.30am and between 3 and 4pm.

The Camden (Tonbridge Street, Bidborough Street, Hastings Street) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 – motor vehicles are prohibited from entering Tonbridge Street at its junction with Cromer Street, and Bidborough Street at its junction with Judd Street on Mondays to Fridays between 8.15 and 9.15am and between 3 and 4pm. Contraflow cycling is permitted in Bidborough Street (from north-east to south-west) between its junctions with Judd Street and Tonbridge Street, in Hastings Street (from south-west to north-west) between its junctions with Judd Street and Tonbridge Street, and in Tonbridge Street (from south-east to north-west) between its junctions with Hastings Street and Bidborough Street.

The Camden (Mount Pleasant) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 – motor vehicles are prohibited from entering the southerly section of Mount Pleasant at its junction with Elm Street on Mondays to Fridays between 8 and 9.15am and between 3 and 4pm.

**The Camden (Croftdown Road) Experimental Traffic Order 2021** – motor vehicles are prohibited from entering the section of Croftdown Road between its junctions with Chester Road and St. Alban's Road on Mondays to Fridays between 8.15 and 9.15am and between 3 and 4pm.

The Camden (Islip Street, Hammond Street) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 – motor vehicles are prohibited from entering the section of Islip Street lying the eastern kerb line of Frideswide Place and the eastern kerb line of Hammond Street, and from entering the section of Hammond Street lying between its junction with Islip Street and a point approximately 41 metres south of that junction on Mondays to Fridays between 8.15 and 9.15am and between 3 and 4pm. Parking places on the on the north side of the aforementioned section of Islip Street are revoked and replaced with a 24-hour prohibition on waiting also applies in Hammond Street from a point approximately 25 metres south of the junction with Islip Street, southwards for a distance of approximately 18.5 metres.

The Camden (Bedford Square) Experimental Traffic Order 2021 – motor vehicles are prohibited from entering the south-eastern arm of Bedford Square at its junction with Bloomsbury Street on Mondays to Fridays between 8 and 9am and between 3 and 4.30pm. Contraflow cycling (from south-west to north-east) is permitted along the south-eastern arm of Bedford Square (from south-west to north-east).

Exemptions to the entry restrictions will apply in respect of vehicles registered to properties in the sections of the streets to which access is only available by passing these entry points, disabled badge holders living in the same sections, vehicles being used to transport disabled children to and from nearby schools and to vehicles being used for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes.

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the experimental orders should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months beginning with the date on which the experimental orders come into force or, if the orders are varied by other orders or modified pursuant to section 10 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation. #### STATEMENT OF REASONS

As part of the Covid-19 enabling safer travel Healthy School Streets Phase 4 programme, officers are proposing the following schools and locations (ward in brackets) to be implemented under an Experimental Traffic Order (ETO). The principle measures will be to prohibit motor vehicles from entering the following locations during the time periods specified on Mondays to Fridays during school term times:

St Mary & St Pancras School Church of England Primary School – Polygon Road (St Pancras and Somers Town).

Restricted times: 8.30-9.30am & 3-4pm.

Argyle Primary School – Tonbridge Street (King's Cross).

Restricted times: 8.15-9.15am & 3-4pm.

Christopher Hatton Primary School – Mount Pleasant (Holborn and Covent Garden).

Restricted times: 8.00-9.15am & 3-4pm.

Brookfield Primary School – Croftdown Road (Highgate).

Restricted times: 8.15-9.15am & 3-4pm.

Kentish Town Church of England Primary School – Islip Street (Kentish Town). **Restricted times:** 8.15-9.15am & 3-4pm.


Ecole Jeanine Manuel School – Bedford Square (Bloomsbury).

Restricted times: 8-9am & 3-4pm.

In addition, footway widening outside the school on Islip Street and a closure of Hammond Street at the junction with Islip Street are being proposed.


It is proposed that the ETO for each scheme would be in place for 18 months. The Council will carry out a Covid-compliant full public consultation after the experimental schemes have been in place for 12 months. This consultation will then, together with relevant information from other sources, (e.g. monitoring data) inform the Council's decision as to whether, at the end of the 18-month experiment, the schemes should be made permanent. Traffic levels will be monitored, as required, on relevant streets in the general vicinity of all 6 schemes before and after the schemes are implemented on a permanent basis.







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
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
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

- In this order the following terms have the meanings respectively ascribed to them;
  - "pedal cycle" has the same meaning as ascribed to it by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 [S. I. 2016 No. 362].
  - "disabled persons badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 [S. I. 2000 No. 682];
  - "school term times" means the term dates of the academic year as published by Argyle Primary School or, if Argyle Primary School makes no such publication of the term dates, the London Borough of Camden in its capacity as the Local Education Authority.
- Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

#### 3. Restrictions

- No person shall cause any vehicle to enter Tonbridge Street at its junction with Cromer Street on Mondays to Fridays between 8.15 and 9.15 am and between 3 and 4pm during school term times.
- No person shall cause any vehicle to enter the section of Bidborough Street which lies between its junctions with Judd Street and Tonbridge Street, at its junction with Judd Street, on Mondays to Fridays between 8.15 and 9.15am and between 3 and 4pm during school term times.

### 4. Modifications to existing orders

The Camden (Prescribed Route) (No. 3) Traffic Order 1995 shall have effect as though the restrictions set out in Article 3 of that order do not apply in respect of a pedal cycle.

- any vehicle registered to an address in Tonbridge Street, that section of Bidborough described in Article 3.2 or that section of Hastings Street which lies between its junctions with Tonbridge Street and Judd Street;
- any vehicle being used to transport a person resident at an address in those streets or sections of streets described in Article 5.1.6 and to whom a disabled persons' badge has been issued;
- 5.1.8 any vehicle which may otherwise be authorised by the council.

The Council of the London Borough of Camden, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 [1984 c. 27], and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following order:

#### 1. Citation and commencement

1.1 This order shall come into force on 24 June 2021 and may be cited as the Camden (Bedford Square) Experimental Traffic Order 2021.

# 2. Interpretation

- 2.1 In this order the following terms have the meanings respectively ascribed to them;
  - **"pedal cycle"** has the same meaning as ascribed to it by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 [S. I. 2016 No. 362].
  - "disabled persons badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 [S. I. 2000 No. 682];
  - "school term times" means the term dates of the academic year as published by Ecole Jeanine Manuel School or, if that school makes no such publication of the term dates, the London Borough of Camden in its capacity as the Local Education Authority.
- Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

#### 3. Restrictions

No person shall cause any vehicle to enter the south-east arm of Bedford Square, at its junction with the north-east arm of Bedford Square and Bloomsbury Street. on Mondays to Fridays between 8 and 9 am and between 3 and 4.30pm during school term times.

No person shall cause any vehicle, other than a pedal cycle, to proceed in the south-east arm of Bedford Square in any direction other than from north-east to south-west.

# 4. Exemptions

- Nothing in Article 3.1 shall apply in respect of;
- 4.1.1 a pedal cycle;
- anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable or traffic warden in uniform;
- a vehicle being used by the police, fire brigade or ambulance services;
- a council vehicle being used in the pursuance of statutory duties;
- any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
- any vehicle registered to an address in the south-eastern arm of Bedford Square, or a vehicle being used to transport a person resident at one of those addresses and to whom a valid disabled persons' badge has been issued;
- any vehicle which may otherwise be authorised by the council.

### 5. Power to modify or suspend this order

Pursuant to Section 10 (2) of the Act of 1984, the Director of Regeneration & Planning, Supporting Communities Directorate, or any person authorised by him may, if it appears to him or such other authorised person essential in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or in the provision of suitable and adequate parking, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this order runs, modify or suspend this order or any of the provisions in this order.

# 2. Interpretation

- 2.1 In this order the following terms have the meanings respectively ascribed to them;
  - "pedal cycle" has the same meaning as ascribed to it by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 [S. I. 2016 No. 362].
  - "disabled persons badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 [S. I. 2000 No. 682];
  - "school term times" means the term dates of the academic year as published by St. Mary and St. Pancras Church of England Primary School or, if that school makes no such publication of the term dates, the London Borough of Camden in its capacity as the Local Education Authority.
- Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

#### 3. Restrictions

No person shall cause any vehicle to enter the section of Polygon Road which lies between its junctions with Werrington Street and Chalton Street Marsden Street on Mondays to Fridays between 8.30 and 9.30am and between 3 and 4pm during school term times.

## 4. Exemptions

- 4.1 Nothing in Article 3.1 shall apply in respect of;
- 4.1.1 a pedal cycle;
- anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable or traffic warden in uniform;
- a vehicle being used by the police, fire brigade or ambulance services;
- a council vehicle being used in the pursuance of statutory duties;
- any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
- any vehicle belonging to a resident living at an address in the section of Polygon Road which lies between its junctions with Werrington Street and Chalton Street, or an address to which vehicular access can only be obtained by entering that section of the road;
- any vehicle being used to transport a person resident at one of those addresses described in Article 4.1.6 and to whom a valid disabled persons' badge has been issued;
- 4.1.8 any other vehicle which may otherwise be duly authorised by the council.

### 5. Power to modify or suspend this order

Pursuant to Section 10 (2) of the Act of 1984, the Director of Regeneration & Planning, Supporting Communities Directorate, or any person authorised by him may, if it appears to him or such other authorised person essential in the interest of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or in the provision of suitable and adequate parking, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this order runs, modify or suspend this order or any of the provisions in this order.
