

Camden Libraries - Acceptable Use Policy for Personal Wi-Fi Access

1. Introduction

Accessing Free Wi-Fi:

Free Wi-Fi is available throughout all Camden Library locations. To connect, just look for 'CamdenGuest'.

When you're using your own device, our Wi-Fi is filtered to block inappropriate content, making it safe for users of all ages.

This Acceptable Use Policy ("AUP") outlines the terms and conditions for accessing Camden Council's Wi-Fi network with your personal device. By connecting to the network, you agree to abide by this AUP.

2. Acceptable Use

The Council's Wi-Fi network is provided for limited use and is intended for:

- Accessing council information and services.
- Browsing the internet for legitimate purposes.
- Engaging in online communication within professional boundaries.

3. Unacceptable Use

The following activities are strictly prohibited while using the Council's Wi-Fi network:

- Downloading or uploading illegal or copyrighted material, including music, movies, software, or games.
- Engaging in activities that violate the law, such as online gambling, harassment, or hate speech.
- Accessing or distributing pornography or other offensive content.
- Using the network for personal gain or commercial purposes.
- Attempting to gain unauthorised access to the Council's network or systems.
- Installing or running software that could harm the network or other devices.
- Sharing your Wi-Fi connection with others without permission.

4. Security

You are responsible for the security of your device while using the Council's Wi-Fi network. The Council is not liable for any loss or damage caused by malware, viruses, or other security breaches. It is highly recommended to:

- Use a strong and unique password for your device.
- Enable firewalls and security software on your device.
- Avoid accessing sensitive information on public Wi-Fi networks.

The Council reserves the right to monitor network activity to ensure compliance with this AUP. The Council may take disciplinary action, including suspension or termination of Wi-Fi access, against users who violate this AUP.
