Responding to the climate emergency

Strategic objective: To ensure that development in Camden responds to the climate emergency by delivering zero carbon development, reducing energy use in existing buildings, optimising resource efficiency, achieving the highest possible environmental standards, and requiring buildings and spaces to be designed and constructed to adapt to, and reduce, the effects of climate change.
